Youth Faith Formation: Saint Project

As we go through our sacramental preparation for Confirmation, Confirmation saints are chosen as a person we want to be like, as well as someone who can pray for us from heaven. This saint is someone you find interest in, who you can pray with, and look to as a role model of the Catholic faith. The Saint you select does not have to be the same as your Baptism Saint. They are also not required to be the same gender as you (ex: If you are a boy, you are welcome to choose St. Joan of Arc as your Saint, a girl can choose St. Francis of Assisi as theirs)

This project requires the completion of 2 things:

1. My saint Worksheet

- a. (see worksheet with this title, it is double sided, please make sure to complete everything)

2. Creative Piece

In addition to completing the worksheet, each Candidate will be allowed the freedom to express him or herself in the creative piece. For your creative piece, reflect on the life of your saint, get inspired and create! The creative piece should be an enjoyable process for you, so please take this opportunity to use your gifts and talents to complete it. Look to your Saint Worksheet for help.

2. Creative Piece examples:

- Create a drawing, painting, collage, sculpture (do not choose this because it's "easy" choose it because it is something you enjoy doing and you do it well.)
- Write a poem, a short story, a song, a play (the use of AI is prohibited, this is a creative piece and using AI is not the way to go)
- Create a diorama, a poster board (make sure that you add images and you do not glue random images to the board, make sure it is intentional.)
- Make a video, a PowerPoint (at least 5 slides, you can use the My Saint Worksheet as a guide but not the slides, get creative!)
- If you have your own idea, great! Clear it by Nohemi first.

You will have to present and explain your creative piece to your class instructor. Class instructor will oversee presentations.

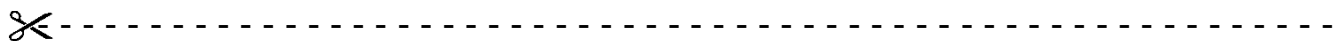
